Textmate

UC Berkeley has a free site-wide license for students to use TextMate, a great code editor for Mac OSX.

1. Follow the link above to download the installation files. Be sure to download the installed (.dmg) AND the license text file (which contains the license key you will need during installation)!
2. Open the .dmg file and drag the TextMate application file to your Applications folder, entering in the license name and key when prompted.

Cyberduck

For this decal, we'll be using a popular free FTP client called Cyberduck.

1. Download the .zip file from the link above.
2. Unzip the file, and drag the Cyberduck application file inside to your Applications folder.
3. To open a new FTP connection, type your username@host (this information will be provided to you) in the 'Quick connect' box, and press connect. Enter in your password when prompted.
4. In the content area, you should be shown folders you have access to on the server.
5. Under 'Action', you can download, upload or sync files/folders. Create a local folder on your machine for your Web Design Decal files, and upload them to the server via the 'upload' command.

From now on, you can choose to sync your files, which will upload any new/changed files to the server for you.
