

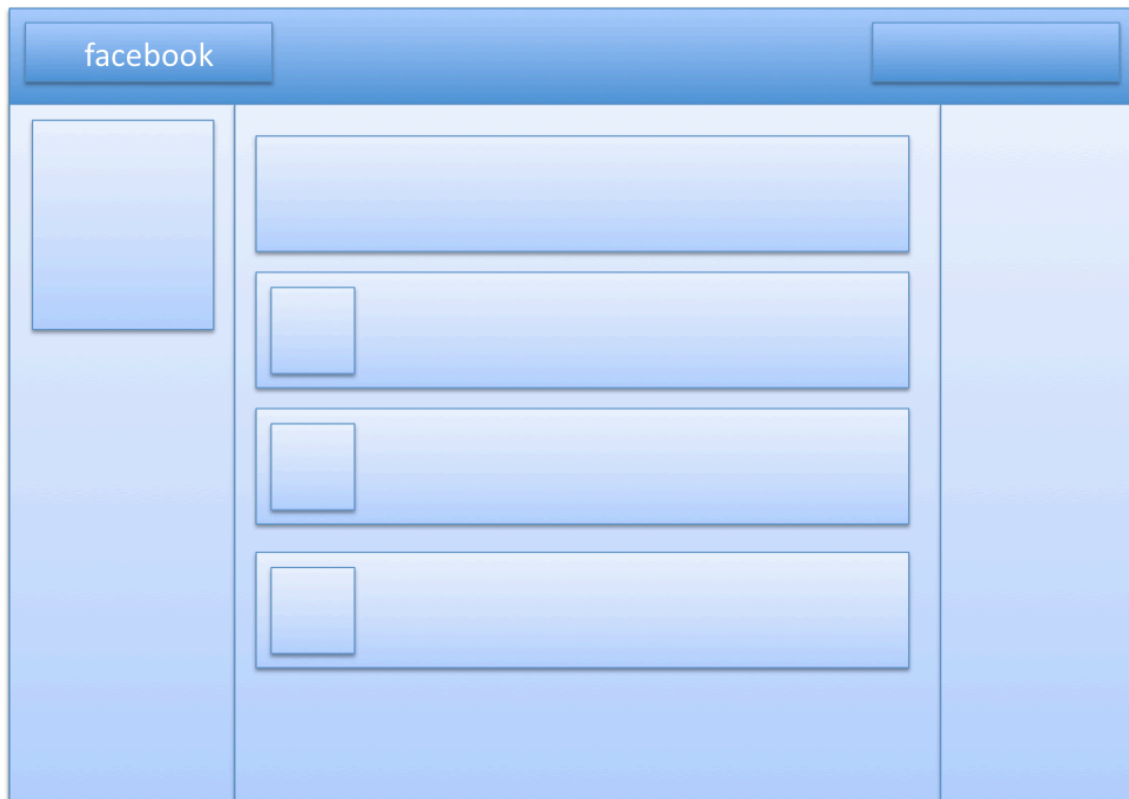
## Lab #6

### Description

This lab requires you to use various CSS techniques to emulate Facebook's website layout.

### Directions

Write HTML and CSS code to make your web page look like this:



#### Notes:

- The top blue gradient goes from #a3c8fb to #5b9ddc
- The pale blue gradient goes from #e9f1ff to #b4d1ff
- The top bar height is 50px
- The left/right sidebars of the bottom content area are both 20%, the middle bottom content area is 60%
- The profile picture box height is 200px
- Each newsfeed item height is 75px, the newsfeed item photos are 50px by 50px

#### Requirements:

- Use floats for the elements in the top header bar
- Use percent widths (NOT fixed pixel widths) for the bottom content sections
- Use gradients and box-shadows on each element so the web page looks like the screenshot (for the most part) -- these effects should work on both Webkit

(Chrome/Safari) AND Firefox browsers. Also, each element should have a border of color #5081b2.

- "facebook" should be vertically centered in the header
- Each newsfeed item should be width 90% of its parent container, and horizontally centered
- There should be NO horizontal scroll bars, and the page should resize correctly if you change the size of the browser window.
- Use ID/classes appropriately
